

Provision for medical needs

As a school we are keen to include children with medical needs and we liaise closely with specialists, such as the diabetes nurse, to make sure that we cater for their needs and ensure they are safe and well.

We have a small number of children in school who need a Care Plan prepared by medical professionals. The Care Plan details routine and emergency procedures for children with conditions including diabetes, epilepsy, severe allergies and metabolic disorders. Staff who are involved with these children are trained each year to make sure that their skills and knowledge are up to date and children are kept safe and healthy.

There is currently a teaching assistant in school who has been trained to give regular physiotherapy sessions to a child who needs them, under professional guidance.

Most of the school is wheelchair accessible and accessibility to some areas has recently been improved by a new ramp and new handrails on the stairs. There is a lift in KS2 and several chair lifts.
