Extended Provision and SEND

Breakfast club, tea club and after school clubs are open to all children whatever their additional needs; additional support will be provided if required. Attendance at out of hours clubs and other events is monitored by the SENCOs to ensure that facilities are used and accessible to pupils with SEND and other vulnerable groups.

Educational visits are planned to include all pupils, again with additional support if necessary, to ensure children can participate fully and safely. Risk assessments for individual pupils may be carried out if required, additional to those for the whole class.

There is a forest school teacher on the staff and although this is not considered a SEND provision it has documented benefits for children with Social, Emotional and Mental Health needs. Children with other additional needs also greatly benefit from this approach in terms of motivation, independence and self-esteem. Adaptations are made for children with physical needs to ensure they can participate in forest school.
