<p>Curriculum</p> <p>Science: Try out a gravity investigation- do you think a heavier object falls faster than a lighter object?</p> <p>PE: Complete 'PE with Joe' – Joe Wicks workouts are on YouTube- try and get the whole family involved if they are able!</p> <p>Are Joe's workouts sometimes too intense? Why not try some yoga? Yoga is a great way to build up strength and stretch those tired muscles! Have a search on YouTube then try and make up some of your own poses!</p> <p>Geography: Use Google Maps to search for a favourite holiday destination (this could be in the UK or abroad). Look at the aerial view of this place. Is it a rural or urban place? What sort of geographical features does it have? (e.g. beaches, cliffs, mountains) Write a fact file for your destination, including things like population, languages spoken as well as if there are any major rivers or other landmarks there.
