



## Writing

- Choose your favourite story to rewrite. You could change the characters or the setting.
- Research VE Day (Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May). Find out why and how it is celebrated. You could present what you have learnt in a non-chronological report.
- Imagine you are a soldier during the war and you have just found out the war is over. Imagine how you would have felt and write a diary entry.
- Write instructions for something you have done. It could be how to plant a sunflower, make a sandwich, how to build something or even how to play a computer game.

### Remember to include:

- Expanded noun phrases to describe something
- Correct spelling and punctuation
- Different conjunctions such as but, when, if, because
- Time connectives

<p><b>Maths</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>☺ Everyday counting with children is invaluable. Continue to practise counting in 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's.</li> </ul> <p><b>Fractions</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>☺ Watch the clips on BBC Bitesize <a href="https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/z3rbg82">https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/z3rbg82</a></li> <li>☺ Ask a grown up if you can help at mealtimes by sharing food into halves, quarters and thirds. When a sandwich is cut into two equal parts, what fraction is each?</li> <li>☺ Cut a piece of paper into halves and write the fraction on each part. Cut another piece of paper into thirds and write the fraction on each part. Cut another piece of paper into quarters and write the fraction onto each part.
